

Volume 14, Number 1 January 2021 St John Lutheran Church is a congregation of the Texas-Louisiana Gulf Coast Synod of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America. Grace to you and peace! As your incoming Interim Pastor, this is the first ministry in my 39 year career where my last name has been familiar at the outset. My father (Bruno) came out of the Zionsville community; 4 generations of my Gaskamp family are buried in that cemetery. Meanwhile my wife Carol, a native of Houston, has generational roots in the William Penn community. We have retired to Washington County, reclaiming the old William Penn farm house where her Feusse grandfather was born.

Following in my father's footsteps as a Lutheran Pastor, I was ordained in 1981. My internship was in a small Wisconsin dairy farming community, and then first 2 calls as a Pastor were in rural western Kansas (wheat farming and ranching), followed by planting a new ministry in the suburbs of Wichita (Ks). When our 2 sons left the nest in 2001, I followed Carol back to Texas to continue her vocation of teaching in a university. In spring of 2002, I was called to plant another new ministry in an Austin exurb, only to discover that the previous playbook for starting a new ministry in 1990 was hardly useful amidst the huge upheaval that came after 9/11.

Since 2015, I have served multiple "interim" appointments within central Texas ELCA congregations, each experiencing unique transitions. My most recent appointment was with the Synod staff of the Southwestern Texas Synod, from which I retired the end of September.

Our two sons live out of state, one in Boston MA area and the other in Olathe KS; through them, we have 6 grandchildren.

Over the last 5+ years, I have discovered "congregational transitions" to be anything but serving as a place holder. There is inevitably grief, uncertainty, anxiety about when a new Pastor will be called, and a desire to rush through this wilderness time.

A huge part of my role will be to listen, ask pertinent questions, accompany you in a time of both grief and uncertainty, and in all of it, wonder with you "Where is God in all of this (WIGIAT)?"

Know up front that I do not see my role as to do all the praying for you. Or, discernment for you of which path to travel forward. I will not be the one to restore St John to a favorite era of the past, and good old days.

Rather, I trust that God is bringing us together in this journey to explore, WIGIAT? To experiment and engage in spiritual practices like a renewed prayer life (which is both speaking AND listening), spending time in scriptures (like stories of journey and challenge), spending time in deep listening for the Spirit's stirring, pointing the way ahead into something new.

Blessings as you now move through the final days of Advent, and celebration of Christmas story, one in which God shows up in unexpected places and ways.

See you in January 2021!

MSC to accept all reports as given.


