

Council President, Jon Westerfeld, called the meeting to order, and Pastor George Rahn opened with prayer. All members were present. Incoming council members were also invited to attend. The November minutes were approved as distributed.

Committee Reports:

<u>Community Concerns Report:</u> Food Pantry served 115 families (130 people) at two distributions in November.

<u>Worship and Music Report:</u> Additional volunteers are needed in all areas of worship: ushers, layreaders, video techs, etc.

Parish Education Report: Approximately 25 children attended Christmas in the Country after Sunday School on December 22. They enjoyed a hayride with hot chocolate, face painting, crafts, and a hot dog lunch. There are 27 children who will participate in the Christmas Program on Christmas Eve.

Evangelism Report: A total of 170 persons were served for the Good Neighbor drive-thru dinner. An additional 5 deliveries were made to shut-in members.

Property Report: Jon Westerfeld will oversee the repair to the Activity Center support. Bids for miscellaneous repairs to the church gutters, fascia, etc. will be presented at the semi-annual congregational meeting. The blue light on the steeple cross will be repaired.
