



CITIZEN ADVOCACY OF CHESTER COUNTY

Do these pandemic restrictions make you feel isolated and disconnected from society? Did you know that people with disabilities often feel isolated, segregated, and are often abused, neglected, and disadvantaged? Are you willing to restore hope, build a long-term friendship and advocate for someone with a disability? Citizen Advocacy of Chester County is a community-based, non-profit organization that recruits, matches and offers support to local citizens with disabilities by establishing advocacy relationships. Advocacy often involves building connection (sending cards, letters and packages through the mail, making phone calls to combat loneliness) and ensuring proper care (food, ethical representation in jobs, and proper care in nursing home facilities).
