FINANCE NEWS (Jan-Oct 2021):

- Pledges are \$9,551 short
- Non-pledges are \$4,356 short
- Expenses are \$24,039 less than had been expected
- The church received \$ 37,606 in Covid-19 grant funds
- Revenues to expenses are favorable at \$11,837, but if we had not received the Covid-19 federal grant and made savings in our operating expenses, our position would be \$61,646 less than it is.




PLEDGE CAMPAIGN UPDATE:


