CELEBRATING QUIMBY PIPE ORGANS OPUS 78

This season of Music at Trinity is like no other. After a year of silence brought about by the pandemic and the revoicing of our organ, we simultaneously celebrate the organ's completion and the lifting of restrictions on gathering and singing.

Quimby Pipe Organs Opus 78 is stunning! Physical alterations have been made to existing pipework, new pipework has been added, wind pressures have been raised--the organ is now equipped to play the widest possible selection of the organ's repertoire, with a warmer, rounder sound that will lead congregational singing better than ever.

We are pleased to inaugurate the organ with six concerts played by musicians of world renown, some of which have served on the staff at Trinity.

Jason Roberts is Music Director at the Church of the Blessed Sacrament in New York City. He has also served at St. Bartholomew's Church in New York and at St. James's Episcopal Church in West Hartford, Connecticut. He is a winner of the American Guild of Organists National Competition in Organ Improvisation, and has been a finalist at competitions in St Albans and Haarlem.

Mr Roberts' program will feature repertoire for the organ, and free and structured improvisation; in addition, he will accompany Buster Keaton's 1921 silent comedy film "The Boat."

Michael Messina is Director of Music at Trinity Episcopal Church. He holds MMus and DMA degrees in Organ Performance and Literature, as well as the Performer's Certificate, from the Eastman School of Music. He has performed solo and duo organ concerts extensively throughout the United States, as well as at the cathedral of Notre-Dame de Paris.

Michael performs Messiaen's landmark work for organ, with projected illuminations of seasonal art assembled by Holly Day, Trinity parishioner and Indianapolis Museum of Art Senior Curator of Contemporary Art, Emerita.

Avi Stein is the associate organist and chorusmaster at Trinity Church Wall Street and is on faculty at the Juilliard School where he teaches continuo accompaniment, vocal repertoire and chamber music. The New York Times described Avi as "a brilliant organ soloist" in his Carnegie Hall debut and he was recently featured in Early Music America magazine in an article on the new generation of leaders in the field. Avi is the Artistic Director of The Helicon Foundation and has directed the International Baroque Academy of Musiktheater Bavaria, the young artists' program at the Carmel Bach Festival. Avi studied at Indiana University, the Eastman School of Music, the University of Southern California and was a Fulbright scholar in Toulouse, France. He was Assistant Organist at Trinity, Indianapolis from 2001-2006.

She has performed, studied, and taught throughout the U.S., England, Egypt, and the West Bank. She holds degrees from The University of Texas at Austin, Boston University, and Indiana University, where she completed her doctorate in organ under the guidance of Janette Fishell. While at IU, she was the assistant organist at Trinity, Indianapolis for five years, 2009-2014.
