Children age 3 through Kindergarten may attend Extended Session during the 10:00 am worship service after they share in our Time with Young Disciples. Caregivers are long time employees of Northridge and are CPR and First Aid Certified.

Infants & Toddler

Even our youngest saints in the Nursery are introduced to faith concepts in age appropriate ways through Frolic's Nursery program.

Preschool - Ages 3 through age 5

This class leverages best practices in early childhood education with Frolic Preschool featuring age-appropriate play spaces, prayers, storytelling, music and rituals. Children explore faith concepts the way they know best – through play!

Kindergarten - 2nd Grade

Children have an innate sense of the presence of God. The Godly Play approach helps them to explore their faith through story, to gain religious language and to enhance their spiritual experience through wonder and play. Based on Montessori principles, Godly Play encourages spiritual formation through wonder at the mystery of God.

Third & Fourth Grade

These students will explore bible stories through hands-on learning activities, interactive games and creative crafts using Sparkhouse's Holy Moly curriculum.

Fifth & Sixth Grade

Jr. High Students (Grades 7-8)

Sr. High Students (Grades 9-12)
