WHY OUR COMMUNITY MATTERS

WHY STEWARDSHIP MATTERS

Stewardship's *etymology* reveals its *theology*. A steward cares for what belongs to someone else. With our Stewardship, we affirm that all we have and all we are, we receive from God – that: "The earth is the Lord's and all that is in it..." *Psalm 24*. With our Stewardship we profess that everything – even our very selves – belongs to God.
