#### DEANERY OFFICERS.

Deanery principal officers are the Convenor, Deputy Convenor (if desired) and Secretary.

#### OFFICER APPOINTMENTS.

Officers are elected by the congregational delegates to the deanery for one year terms. Elections will take place at the March meeting. The Secretary shall send new officer information to Diocese House via e-mail within five business days. New officer information must include: clerical rank if appropriate; first and last name; full postal mailing address; home, work and cellular telephone numbers as appropriate; and email address.

(Delegates are elected by their fellow parishioners at the delegate's church annual meeting for one year terms; they also are elected to serve as delegates to the annual diocesan convention.)

### **MEETINGS.**

Deanery meeting participants are the elected congregational diocesan convention delegates.

Deaneries meet at least three times a year ensuring a meeting is held in the month prior to convention: March, September and November. Meetings may rotate within the deanery region at the discretion of the convenor with delegate consensus.

## **CONVENOR'S DUTIES.**

Organize meetings in the months as above with specific dates, times and locations. Make sure the secretary is available to take Minutes. Make sure the Meeting is conducted in accordance with Robert's Rules of Order. Make sure you have all the delegates contact information from the churches in your deanery. Solicit agenda items of constructive substance from delegates at least 30 days before the Meeting. Make sure the secretary sends the final agenda to the delegates at least one week before the Meeting.
