

Permission to participate and Release form for Camp Marshall, Summer 2020



Participant Acknowledgements:

I give permission for my child to access the Zoom platform using the password provided by Camp Marshall to participate in large and small group activities. I will not share the Camp Marshall log-in information to Zoom or the password to the protected webpage on Camp Marshall's website. If my child is under the age of 12, I agree to have an adult nearby who is available during the hours of virtual camp. I will set up my child's access to the internet/virtual camp in a place other than his/her bedroom. I will be aware of his/her background and what/who is visible. I release Camp Marshall from any responsibility for use of internet searches outside of camp channels. I agree to talk to my child about being online, such as safety, online searches, oversharing and cyberbullying.

General Release:

I give permission for my child to virtually attend Camp Marshall and participate in the scheduled program. I recognize the possible risk involved for my child in participating in online activities, including risks associated with online piracy, security, and invasion of privacy. I release, discharge, and otherwise agree to indemnify Camp Marshall, its affiliated organizations and sponsors, its officers, directors, employees, volunteers, and agents against any claim by or on behalf of myself or my minor child as a result of my child's participation in any program or activity sponsored, coordinated, or supervised by Camp Marshall.

I give permission on behalf of myself and my minor child for photographs/or video to be taken of my child to be used for publicity purposes by Camp Marshall. I agree on behalf of myself and my minor child that photographs/videos are the property of Camp Marshall and Camp Marshall shall have the right to reproduce, publish in print, online, and/or via social media these photos and videos as they desire free and clear of any claims on my, or my minor child's, part. I further give permission and agree on behalf of myself and my minor child that any photographs may be published and used by Camp Marshall and the Episcopal Camps and Conference Centers and its agents, to illustrate and promote the camp experience, Camp Marshall, and its camp programs, or the Episcopal Camp and Conference Centers.

I give permission for the Camp Marshall staff to discuss my child's health and any information I provide to the director for the purpose of program participation. *Since the camp is online we do not ask for health records for all participants.

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Camper Code of Conduct:

Our hope is that Camp Marshall will be a place for campers to make friends and find support. In order for Camp Marshall to be safe, fun and enjoyable for everyone, there are some expectations to discuss with your child.

1. I will abide by any rules outlined by Camp Marshall staff or their designees during the program.
2. Alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, smoking or tobacco products are not allowed during the hours of virtual camp. Camp Marshall has the right to remove a camper from the Zoom meeting without warning if the Camp Director suspects these products have been used.
3. Sexual or suggestive behavior/comments/conversations is not appropriate or acceptable at Camp Marshall.
4. Campers will only use the Zoom platform to contact camp staff and fellow campers during the scheduled camp times.
5. Screen shots, recording, and private, separate chats are not allowed during virtual camp sessions.
6. My background will be appropriate, such as, but not limited to, a blank wall, virtual background image, or the poster provided by Camp Marshall.
7. I will follow the guidelines for appropriate chat conversations.
 - a. If you ever feel uncomfortable, tell your trusted adult
 - b. No secrets. (Surprises are different. Surprises make us feel good and are intended to share eventually. Secrets are not ever meant to share and can feel bad.)
 - c. Good messages are ones that parents/guardians are excited to see and hear and the person sharing it with you would want your parents/guardians to see and hear the message.
 - d. Cussing, swearing and foul language is not acceptable at Camp Marshall.

Video submissions from Families:

parents/kids speak into the camera their names, that they understand their image is being filmed for the project and they give permission for those images to be used in a video library located on YouTube.

Recording on the Virtual Platform:

- Yes, I give permission for Camp Marshall to record virtual sessions where my child is present.
- No, I do not give permission for Camp Marshall to include my child when recording virtual sessions. It is a best practice to keep your child's camera off when attending online meetings. (The camp director, or his designee, may also disable your child's camera and mute his/her audio during all recorded sessions.)
