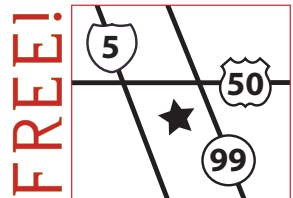
“The Gathering,” a new creative community in Sacramento that encourages the sharing
