EXECUTIVE ORDER 9066:

WHERE DID MY NEIGHBOR GO?

On February 19, 1942, President Franklin D. Roosevelt signed Executive Order 9066, which ordered all Japanese American citizens to evacuate the West Coast, citing their threat during the nation's war with Japan. Ultimately, approximately 120,000 people were forced to relocate to internment camps across the country.

On September 13, we will hear the stories of four local Japanese-Americans who were uprooted from their homes and sent to internment camps throughout the country.

A light Japanese-style dinner will be served at 6 p.m., followed by the program at 7 p.m. This event is **FREE**; a donations basket will be available.
