Pastor's Ponderings



Last month I started sharing the responses from the Congregational Study and some of the actions that we were moving toward. The Session reviewed two bids to add a video component to our worship and enhance our video broadcasts for the Cable and livestreaming. One bid was from AVI out of Des Moines for \$42,930 and the other from Josh Ullom who just did a similar system for Spirit of Life Presbyterian Church in Apple Valley, MN for \$17,032. The Session approved the second bid as we have the finances with the grant from presbytery and memorial funds. Steve Danielson is working on the audio equipment and adding microphones and speakers. Here are other responses from the Congregational Study:

Pastor's Ponderings Cont.

What are the most significant weaknesses of your church? Many people said there are fewer people than there used to be; inactive members; we are not diverse. As with most churches many said there are too few younger families. The choir is smaller. The pool of people willing to participate in the worship support positions is shrinking; limited finances; No PW; miss Bible Study; Age of the building, and its size; need for repairs; need to repair stained glass windows

What changes would you like to see made in your church? The Education wing, Is there any potential value in separating it from the rest of the facility? People need to step out of their comfort zone and be willing to try new things. We need to grow the congregation. Occasionally have different music. Updating equipment. Marketing, getting our name out in the community; being involved in the community. Forest Ridge kids used to come to worship; connect with college kids.

Describe ethnic groups in our community: Hispanic- are starting new churches, African American, Asian Does the membership of our congregation reflect the ethnic and socio-economic groups of our community? Many said no; area jobs are attracting new ethnic groups; local kids tend to leave Describe three distinctive attributes of your community: College; farmers; good local hospital; safe community; new pool; Apple Orchard

Identify major trends you envision in your community during the next five years: More number of ethnic groups; older population; less retail. Some churches merging; new industries, new housing being built Hope: more people coming back to churches; searching for what is really important

List problem areas confronting your community that members feel your church should address:

Percentage of people attending church is declining; Our Meet the Needs program is going well

Are there things that we as a church might do to address those needs both for individuals and the community as a whole? Meals; Holiday box for those in need- People could come to the church to receive it

Music in the Park programs; kids activities.

What do you think our congregation will look like in 20 years if we continue the pattern of the last 20 years without operating differently? The responses were all the same: empty; it won't be here; closed.

What do people in the community know about our church? (Is there a way to use the question as an outreach opportunity to connect with people): Have an open house in the style of Christmas Tour of Homes; Work with Brett Fuelberth on music programs; Salad luncheon used to be popular.

Our congregation is perceived to be theologically diverse holding a variety of views.

What are some ways we could make our building more inviting? Use Greeters; have more people in worship; our stairs are a challenge. Fix cracks; maintenance, it is an old building that needs work and

worship; our stairs are a challenge. Fix cracks; maintenance, it is an old building that needs work and handicap accessibility; transform the look of the east entry; there is a spot on the wall behind the piano; pipes in the basement are stained; improve basement lighting. Signage to direct people to the chair lift and bathrooms. Work needs to be done in the upstairs bathrooms to make them look better inside. We could stencil Bible verses on walls, doors, etc.

Is there a way not to have the basement bathrooms open into the dining room (add a hallway for access).

Pastor's Ponderings Cont.

Change the bulletin board from the old one on rollers; have a display rack instead of card table. Signs outside the church; might it be possible to have a portable sign on the Laundromat corner? Welcome banners; electronic sign; add color. The Methodists put out flags around the block, is there something we could do? Add a flagpole and light it, display US and Christian flag [George Shadle will donate them].

There are certainly a lot of possible things we can work on from the suggestions in the responses to these questions. There is not space to include all the responses this month, so I will continue the list next month. Our time of discussion needs to be an ongoing one. We had good responses from those who participated in the Congregational Study, but I would appreciate hearing from those who were not able to be in the meetings. Your input is valuable to share.
