

## In-Person Worship Guidelines

- ASPC follows the guidelines set by the CDC and the City of Philadelphia. Per the city's mandate, all community members are required to wear a mask for the duration of the indoor service regardless of vaccination status.
  - Masks (N95/KN95) and hand sanitizer will be available in the sanctuary.
- In order to provide adequate social distancing, our seating capacity will be limited. To safely accommodate our guests, we ask guests to register for service using the link found on our website.
  - If you have registered for worship and feel unwell on Sunday morning, we ask that you join us for worship virtually on our Zoom platform until you are feeling better. The Zoom link is also posted on our website.
- We are not providing childcare for this week's service but we are planning a safe re-entry for our families with young children. Please stay tuned for updates.
- Limited printed bulletins will be available. We encourage worshipers to download the bulletin from the website and/or access it on a mobile device during worship.
- Upon receiving the benediction, worshippers will be asked to maintain distance when moving toward the exit doors.
- Coffee hour will be reduced to pre-packaged treats.
