From Our Interim Pastor

Grace and peace to you!

One of the great opportunities that we have been celebrating in the midst of the challenges associated with the corona virus is using technology to proclaim the Good News in new ways!



First off I want to thank all of those who have helped us upgrade what has become our portable sound system. This is the equipment that we have been using on Sunday mornings when we gather to worship on the lawn. We had the speakers, but the

mixer and the wireless microphones are new. The system is fairly portable, in that we can move it to the gym or outside around the property.

We also made some significant investments in video equipment that we are bringing online now. There is a new broadcast quality camera in the Sanctuary, and a smaller portable camera that we can use wherever we need to. This system is controlled by a new laptop that livestreams the video to our YouTube channel. Our internet capabilities also needed to be upgraded, and all of this should be completed early in September.

Thank you for making all of those upgrades and improvements possible.

I will begin teaching a Bible study on Paul's letter to the Romans on Monday night September 14, at 6:00 pm on Zoom. We will also continue to meet on Tuesday evening, September 15, for a prayer gathering on Zoom at 6:00 pm. I will be sending out invitations to these events the week of the meetings on the church email list.

The daily devotionals will continue to go out as well.

Church Office Hours


