

A Bible Study Guide for Reading, Studying and Sharing Scripture.

1. Begin with Prayer
2. Read the passage and ask; “What did I hear?”
What caught your attention? What is the reading saying? What surprised you in the reading? What concerned you in the reading?
3. Which person(s) in the passage caught your attention?
4. What do we know about the historical background of the passage? (Go online to find information on the passage.)
5. What words caught your attention in the passage?
6. What are our ‘devotional’ understandings of the text?
How have we heard this passage talked about before?
8. What theological, moral or social issues are raised in the passage?
9. What is God calling us to do in response? What is God saying to us, saying to me, in this passage?
10. End with prayer and the Lord’s Prayer. Ask others with you who and what they want to lift up in prayer.

Consider using “Taking Faith Home” which has a daily Bible References for each week or taking one book of the Bible (Mark or Luke for example) and then take one chapter at a time. Take turns having those in the group read the passage one paragraph at a time.

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
